Board Certification/BCD, Clinical Social Worker Psychoanalyst

Criteria for BCDs who are psychoanalytic institute graduates

Orraining, graduate of a psychoanalytic institute training program

Personal analysis by a training analyst or equivalent (at least 5-years of post-graduate experience as a psychoanalyst), in-person, for a minimum of 40 weeks/300 hours during a year (at a frequency of 3-5 sessions per week, on separate days)

◊Supervision

-Supervised in practice for a minimum of 150-200 hours by a training analyst or equivalent

-Supervised <u>in conducting</u> two adult psychoanalysis cases, at least one was supervised to completion—lasting at least two years in one instance, and at least one year in the other

Ocurrency of Practice, within the past year a minimum of...

- -300 hrs. of clinical social work practice informed by psychoanalytic theory
- -Formal psychoanalysis with at least two clients

Continuing Education, within the past three years, 40 clock hours of clinical continuing education, of which 50% can be identified as psychoanalytically oriented

Orect Practice, within three years or more...

-4,500 hours of post-master's clinical social work practice informed by psychoanalytic theory

♦Practice Evaluation, successful evaluation by two colleagues/supervisors/ consultants who are clinical social work psychoanalysts or analysts who are clinical psychologists or psychiatrists

Additional Requirements for those not board-certified

In order to attain the psychoanalysis credential you must meet the criteria for the *Board Certified Diplomate* (BCD) of the American Board of Examiners in Clinical Social Work (ABE):

- Master's (or Doctoral) degree in social work with coursework & field work focused on direct practice
- Highest clinical licensure in each state or jurisdiction in which you practice (unless exempted by terms of government employment)
- ♦ 5 years/7,500 hours of post-graduate clinical practice (2 years/3,000 hours of this practice must be under supervision)
- Evaluation of practice by a colleague/supervisor/consultant who is a Clinical Social Worker (BCD or BCD-eligible)
